Description: The Richmond Terminal is a Richmond, VA centric approach to modeling the RF&P in the mid-1990s. The railroad represents Acca Yard to Quantico using 9.5 scale miles of mainline track over 2 levels of railroad, with many prototypical track layouts and locations represented, based on documentation and research. ABS Signaling has been implemented with Layout Command Control and JMRI across the entire mainline. Layout has been operational on both decks since – 2022.
